DESCRIPTION: The historic Timber Cove Inn is located on a scenic oceanfront bluff on the ruggedly beautiful Sonoma Coast north of San Francisco and just fifteen miles north of Jenner, where the famed Russian River meets the Pacific Ocean. It is a short drive from spectacular cliffs and accessible beaches including Goat Rock State Park. Including 22 acres of forest and seaside trails, Timber Cove Inn provides guests with an oceanfront setting far away from the demands of everyday life, yet in close proximity to wineries and a myriad of outdoor activities. Individuals and groups will enjoy public areas with stunning views, a massive stone fireplace/bar, fine dining and a new wine tasting room, special event room with cove view, ocean view trail along the cliffs around the property, and special event lawn. Built in 1963, it is home to several renowned art pieces, including two by Beniamino Bufano. Timber Cove Inn has been enhanced by renovations of the rooms, lobby and restaurant in 2008-2009.

ACCOMMODATIONS: At Timber Cove Inn, rustic charm collides with breathtaking ocean views. Most of the 50 rooms have private spa tubs, fireplaces and either ocean, cove or forest views. Other rooms surround a serene Japanese garden. All rooms were renovated in 2008 and feature flat screen TVs, robes, and new plush white bedding.

- RESTAURANT:** Open for breakfast, lunch and dinner, the inn's fine dining restaurant, Alexander's at Timber Cove, features a menu that makes use of local ingredients that include organic fruits and vegetables, Sonoma cheeses, organic farm-raised chicken, lamb, and local seafood including oysters from Tomales Bay, salmon and Dungeness crab. The wine list highlights acclaimed Sonoma wines from the Sonoma Coastal appellation among wines throughout the region. Special events include winemaker dinners and entertainment in the Sequoia Lounge. Executive Chef Jon Mortimer was nominated for a James Beard Award in 2008.
- SONOMA COAST TASTING ROOM:** Open to the public on weekends from noon to 5 p.m., the new Sonoma Coast Tasting Room, which is located beside the beautiful Timber Cove Inn lobby, features wine experts and their wines from local boutiques wineries including Flowers Winery, Hirsch Vineyards, Fort Ross Vineyard and more. Tasting room visitors can enjoy four 2-oz. tastings of wine (\$15-\$20) with the option of a four-course cheese pairing for \$10. Shipping is available for purchases. Corkage will be complimentary for guests that purchase a bottle of wine to accompany their dinner at Alexander's.
- WEATHER:** Winter - brisk mid 50s; Spring - low 60s; Summer - low 70s
- DRIVING DIRECTIONS:** Timber Cove Inn is located on Highway 1, fourteen miles north of Jenner. While meandering up Highway 1, guests need not be alarmed by the grass-loving locals. Sonoma County cows are friendly and likely to be seen along the route.
- NEAREST AIRPORT AND CARRIERS:** Several major airports serve the San Francisco Bay Area including the San Francisco International Airport and the Oakland International Airport. However, the closest airport to Timber Cove is the Charles M. Schulz/Sonoma County Airport, which offers service on Alaska and Horizon airlines to Las Vegas, Los Angeles, Portland and Seattle.
